Privacy

The Children's Cancer & Blood Foundation (CCBF) has established this privacy policy to demonstrate our commitment to maintaining the confidentiality and privacy of information about donors and visitors to our website. This policy explains why we collect information and how we will use it. We encourage you to read this privacy policy and check back often to find any new updates to the policy. *CCBF's privacy policy is enforced regardless of whether we collect a donor's information online through our website or through an offline donation.*

Information We Collect

To better understand our supporters and their interests and needs, we may periodically collect personal information from our site visitors. Personal information is anything that enables us to identify you in some way, such as your name, email address, or phone number. If you make a donation on our website, our donation management company, Network For Good, requires you to fill out personal information to process your donation. This information is never sold or given to a third party. Nor do we store any sensitive information, such as your social security number or financial institution.

Partnerships

CCBF partners with a number of other organizations to further the mission of our work. Every now and then, CCBF's partners may want to send you information about an event linked to CCBF. However, we will never add your name to another company's database.
